

Go to the website below to create an account unless one has already been created for you.



You will then be prompted to create and account (you will have to provide your name, email and agency: Town of Tisbury) and password. When creating an account, you will receive and email to authenticate your credentials. Once you have confirmed by clicking the email, they send to your email then you will be able to complete the training on the website. You will then have 30 days to complete the training.




Once you have created an account/verified your email by clicking on the email sent to you by the state and then created your password you can now complete the training.

Screen shot below is what will be displayed on your screen and you will launch the training by clicking on the Launch tab




CODE OF ETHICS AND CONDUCT AND OPEN MEETING LAW DIRECTIONS
