## TISBURY WATERWAYS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

1) Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 5:30pm.

**Public Comment:** Lynn Fracker commented on the Committee as an important recourse and encouraged continued engagement and working with the Chair to bring important agenda items to the Committee.

**Minutes**: Paul Munafo made a motion and John Packer seconded to approve the minutes of **1/14/2021** (5-0 abstain)

## 2) Chair Opened up meeting for Discussion Items:

**Harbor Use Permit:** Greg Martino has made an application for Harbor Use to the Owen Park Pier for pick up and drop of point for his Oyster Farm Tours. After discussion Matt Hobart made a motion and Paul Munafo seconded to recommend to the Select Board to approve the Harbor Use Permit with any conditions set by the Select Board **(Approved 6-1 abstain)** 

Waterways Regulations: Matt Hobart gave a presentation of an overview of the recommended changes to the Waterways Committee explaining the previous committees work involved in the recommended changes and the reasons for the changes. The purpose was to bring those committee members who had not served prior some clarification and understanding regarding the changes. Matt went over the changes that were included in Phase 1 of the discussions. Further discussion included Phase 1 and Phase 2.

Waterways Regulations Phase 2: Jeff Canha presented Phase 2 to the Waterways Committee and explained that there will be further in-depth discussion with respect to Phase 3 including House Boats and Liveaboards. During discussion it was suggested to keep the recommended changes moving forward that the committee meet on a bi-weekly basis keeping the Waterways Regulations as the only agenda item. John Packer made a motion and Roger Moffat seconded for the Waterways Committee meet on February 25, 2021 at 5:30 pm to discuss Phase 1 and Phase 2 if time permits. (Approved 7-0)

**Shellfish Regulations:** Danielle Ewart presented to the Committee some recommended changes to the Shellfish Regulations. There was discussion regarding the changes in the Hardship section of the regulations. It was suggested that to have further time to review the changes and that the recommended changes to regulations be deferred until the March Waterways Committee meeting to allow more time for discussion.

Shellfish/Water Quality 10 Year Historical Report: Danielle Equard made a presentation regarding the history and water quality of the Waterways over the past ten years. She talked about seeding projects and the number of seed planted for growing and the work done in partnership with the Shellfish Group. She also gave a history showing the number of shellfish permits issued in 1953 vs 2020. She explained how water quality was conducted by the Division of Marine Fisheries and the types of testing done for water pollutants. She described the five classification statuses in Massachusetts and indicated those areas on he Tisbury Shellfish Classification map. Danielle will forward the presentation to Committee Members and post it on the Shellfish web page.

Harbormaster – Woods Hole Group Clarification regarding scope and point to contact for dredging question. John Crocker had sent Committee Members a copy of the scope of the project and contract signed by the Select Board in 2019. He informed the committee that any questions regarding the project should be directed to him.

Harbormaster and Shellfish Departments possible Lake Tashmoo Eel Grass Study. John Crocker explained that both departments were looking doing a joint eel grass study in Lake Tashmoo. The last study was conducted in 2013 by the state and it was felt somewhat outdated. There was discussion and the Committee asked the they be provided with a map of where the potential dive sites will be located. After further discussion John Packer made a motion and Greg Martino seconded to table the subject until the next Waterways Committee in March. Approved (4-0)

John Packer made a motion to adjourn and Paul Munafo seconded to adjourn.
