

E. DINGHY AND SMALL CRAFT USE AND STORAGE

9. Dinghies may not remain on the floating dinghy docks for more than 72 hours. The Harbormaster may remove inactive Dinghies from the floating docks after 72 hours.

9. Dinghies shall not be kept on dinghy docks for storage or left for extended periods without regular use. The Harbormaster may determine when a dinghy is being stored rather than used and may direct its removal from the dock. Evidence of non-use may include, but is not limited to, excessive marine growth, accumulation of water or debris, or other signs of neglect. Owners shall be responsible for all costs associated with removal and storage.

9. Dinghies shall not be kept on dinghy docks for storage or left unattended for extended periods without regular use or maintenance. The Harbormaster may determine when a dinghy is being stored, abandoned, or otherwise not actively maintained and may direct its removal from the dock. Evidence of non-use or abandonment may include, but is not limited to, accumulation of water, excessive marine growth, debris, deterioration, or other visible signs that the dinghy has not been regularly attended to. Owners shall be responsible for all costs associated with removal and storage.
