- All newly elected members had been sworn in and submitted the necessary papers. The siting FinCom members and Finance Director/Treasurer Jonathon Snyder introduced themselves and gave a brief review of their Town government experience. Both new members were looking forward to working and learning on the FinCom.
- Seth Gambino, owned the burrito shop on Main St. and had a background in restaurants, night clubs and corporate management. He had just narrowly lost the election for Selectmen.
- Lolly Hand had a background in teaching and education administration. The FinCom welcomed and congratulated them on their election.
- Pamela Brock submitted her letter of resignation (see documents on file). Sara York was interested in rejoining the Board.
