## Positive COVID-19 Cases on Martha's Vineyard

### 31 new confirmed positive cases, 3 new probable cases

Saturday – 20 confirmed cases (11 MVH, 7 TestMV, 2 other providers) 1 symptomatic positive

Sunday – 4 confirmed cases (2 MVH, 1 TestMV, 1 other provider)

Monday – 7 confirmed cases (2 MVH, 5 TestMV) 1 antigen positive, 1 symptomatic positive

### 706 Total cases to date

#### 662 confirmed positive individuals (PCR positive tests)

Individuals may be tested more than once to confirm illness or, in certain situations, to be released from isolation. This may result in a discrepancy between the number of positive individuals and the number of positive tests reported.
