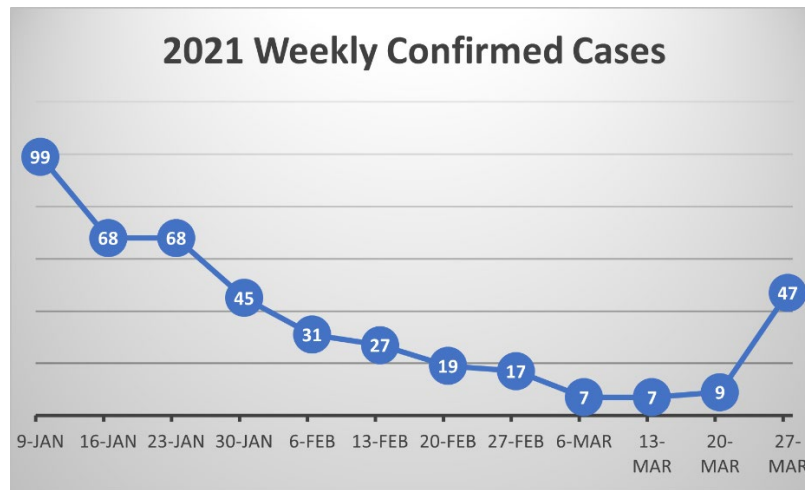


Martha's Vineyard Boards of Health

Weekly positive COVID-19 Case report



March 21st through March 27th, 2021

47 confirmed positive cases (36 MVH, 7 TestMV, 1 Tribe, 1 school testing, 2 off-island providers)
32 symptomatic, 9 asymptomatic, 6 unknown
One probable case

1,055 total cases to date:

996 confirmed positive cases (PCR positive tests)

LINKED CASES

377 cases or 38% of positive cases are connected to at least one other case. Most connections are within family/Household members or small social groups. Three of the connected groups are considered clusters.

2-person group – 57 instances – 114 cases

3-person group – 26 instances – 78 cases

4-person group – 15 instances – 60 cases

5-person group – 8 instance – 40 cases

6-person group – 2 instance – 12 cases

9-person group – 1 instance – 9 cases

10-person group – 1 instance – 10 cases

Clusters: October Wedding – 8 cases

Cronig's Market – 19 cases

Bible Study – 11 cases (5 participants, 6 family/household members)

MV Hospital – 5 cases

Project Headway – 4 cases

King's Barbershop – 7 cases

Completed = No longer symptomatic and released from isolation

Referred to off island health dept = case referred due to patient relocation

In progress = Still being followed by public health

Lost to follow-up = unable to contact
