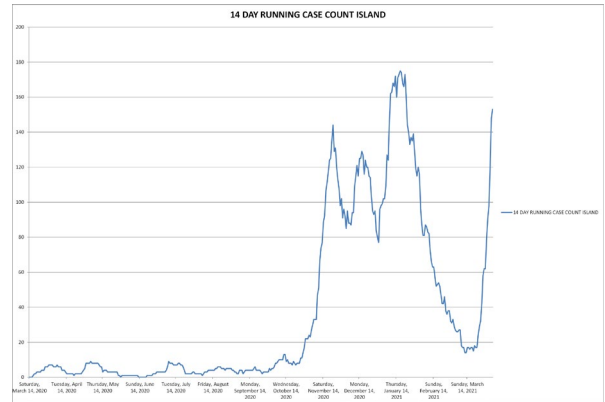
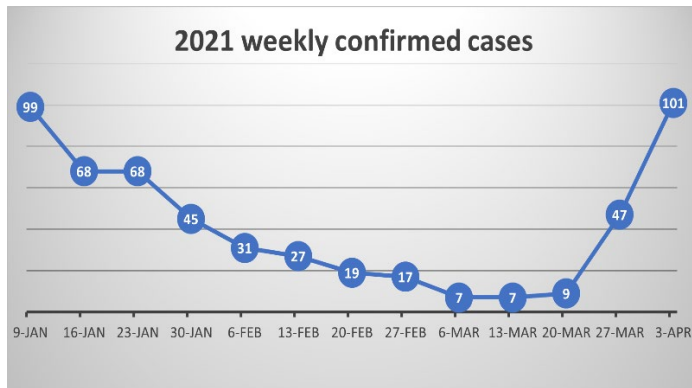

March 28th through April 3rd, 2021

101 confirmed positive cases (71 MVH, 24 TestMV, 1 school testing, 1 school & MVH, 4 off-island providers)
 63 symptomatic, 17 asymptomatic, 21 unknown
 2 probable cases

1,158 total cases to date:

1,097 confirmed positive cases (PCR positive tests)

LINKED CASES

398 cases or 36% of positive cases are connected to at least one other case.

- 2-person group – 58 instances – 116 cases
- 3-person group – 27 instances – 81 cases

- 6-person group – 2 instance – 12 cases
- 9-person group – 1 instance – 9 cases

3/21 – 3/27 47 cases - 34 symptomatic, 10 asymptomatic, 3 unknown
44 completed, 3 in progress

Completed = No longer symptomatic and released from isolation
Referred to off island health dept = case referred due to patient relocation
In progress = Still being followed by public health
Lost to follow-up = unable to contact
