1,154 confirmed positive individuals (PCR positive tests)

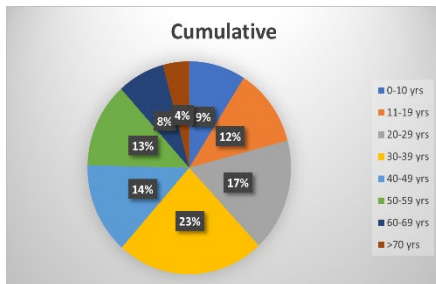

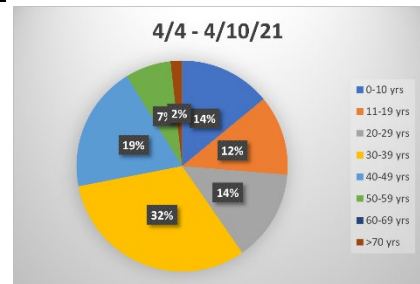
