Description of Work: The work under this Contract consists of the reconstruction of Beach Road in the Town of Tisbury from the Five Corners intersection (Sta. 10+32) to the termination of the existing shared use path east of Wind's Up Marketplace (Sta. 36+64) for a total 2,632' length of project.

The work under this Contract includes, but is not limited to, excavation; full depth construction; paving; constructing driveways, cement concrete sidewalks and wheelchair ramps; hot mix asphalt shared use path; removing and resetting existing granite curb and installing new curbing; drainage; waterworks; providing and spreading loam borrow and seed; landscaping including coastal plantings; installation of traffic signing and pavement markings, traffic control management, dune restoration, beach nourishment, coastal erosion control, and other street improvements.

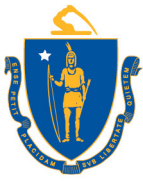
