SUPPLEMENTAL AND EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY ORDER OF THE TISBURY BOARD OF SELECTMEN AND THE TISBURY BOARD OF HEALTH

PERSONS LIVING IN TOWN TO STAY AT THEIR PLACE OF RESIDENCE EXCEPT FOR ESSENTIAL ACTIVITIES

Please read this Order carefully. Violation or failure to comply is punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000 under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 111, Section 122.

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, the Board of Selectmen and Board of Health of the Town of Tisbury adopted, and on March 25, 2020 amended, a moratorium on all construction activity within the Town, effective until 12:00 pm on April 7, 2020;

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, the Board of Selectmen and Board of Health of the Town of Tisbury adopted an Order requiring all persons to stay at their places of residence except for essential activities (the "Stay at Home Order");

WHEREAS, the Governor of the Commonwealth has declared a state of emergency in response to COVID-19, and has issued a further Order on March 23, 2020 entitled COVID-19 Order No. 13, and, whereas, on March 31, 2020, the Governor extended the operation of COVID-19 Order No. 13 to provide for the closure of non-essential businesses until May 4, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS CHAPTER 111, §§95 - 105, AND IN ORDER TO SLOW THE SPREAD OF COVID-19, THE BOARD OF HEALTH AND BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF TISBURY VOTE TO SUPPLEMENT AND EXTEND OUR STAY AT HOME ORDER SO AS TO BE IN EFFECT UNTIL 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, MAY 4, 2020, OR UNTIL OUR FURTHER ORDER.
