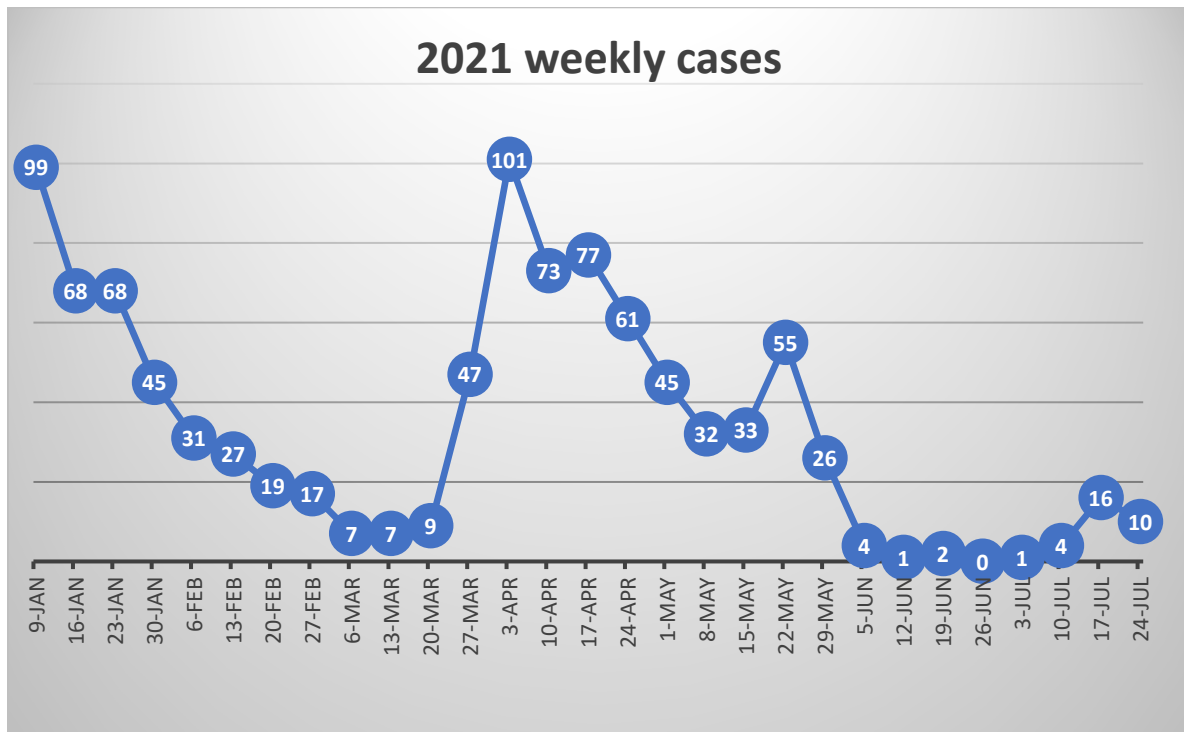

July 18th through July 24th, 2021

10 confirmed positive cases (9 MVH, 1 TestMV)
 8 in progress, 2 completed
 10 symptomatic
 6 fully vaccinated, 4 unvaccinated

4 cases positive for Delta Variant - 6 samples tested, 2 results pending (not all cases are tested for variants)

1,619 total cases to date:

1,537 confirmed positive cases (PCR positive tests)

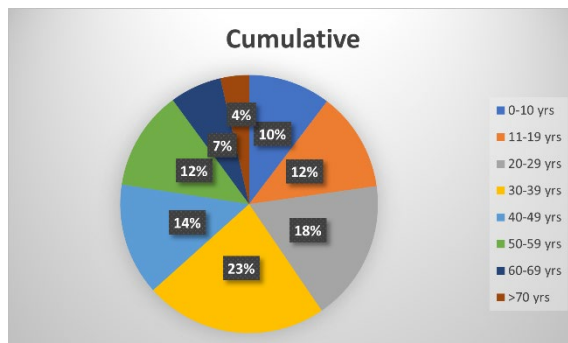

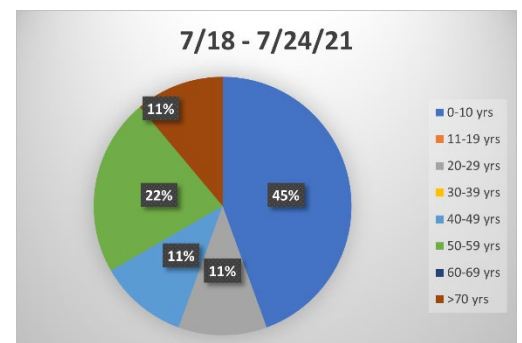

LINKED CASES

571 cases or 37% of positive cases are connected to at least one other case.

- 2-person group – 93 instances – 186 cases
- 3-person group – 41 instances – 123 cases
- 4-person group – 21 instances – 84 cases
- 5-person group – 10 instance – 50 cases
- 6-person group – 4 instance – 24 cases
- 9-person group – 1 instance – 9 cases
- 10-person group – 1 instance – 10 cases
- 12-person group – 1 instance – 12 cases

- October Wedding – 8 cases
- Cronig's Market – 19 cases
- Bible Study – 11 cases
- MV Hospital – 5 cases
- Project Headway – 4 cases
- King's Barbershop – 8 cases (2 staff, 2 customers, 4 family members)
- Shirley's Hardware – 6 cases (all staff)
- Barn Bowl & Bistro – 9 cases (6 staff, 3 family members)
- Cardboard Box – 3 cases (all staff)

Lost to follow-up = unable to contact
