An Overview of Wastewater Planning in Tisbury

The Town has been working on wastewater solutions and technologies that will ultimately fulfill the twin goals of allowing development while decreasing the contamination in our two primary estuaries, Lagoon pond and Lake Tashmoo. The Tisbury Wastewater Planning and Sewer Advisory Committee will sponsor an overview of three current projects.

1. Upgrades and improvements to our current Wastewater Treatment Facility and plans for a new State Road Sewer District presented by our consultants from Environmental Partners Group.
2. An overview of the vertical leach fields, also known as wicks, that will be part of the future growth in our sewerage capacity. Two wick wells have been installed and permitted on town property at the Tisbury School. Wright-Pierce will talk about the connection and testing program for their future use.
3. A presentation by CES Clean Water describing an advanced nitrogen-removal alternative septic technology that is currently being piloted in Tisbury under a grant from the Massachusetts Clean Energy Center in collaboration with the Tisbury Board of Health.

The Town will be asking for funding approval for several warrant articles at this spring's town meeting in order to continue the planning and implementation of these improvements. We encourage you to attend this important presentation to learn about the work that has been accomplished and prepare for town meeting.
