April – August - 2022 - IT Department -- Quick Summary:

- Another set of complete upgrades for user workstations/monitors, installed, configured, and tested,
 - o Still have about 3 more for immediate upgrades, very outdated ones, working w/users, equipment was ordered in June of 2022.
- Troubleshooting Owen Park camera, diagnosis is it's dead and will need to be replaced.
- Hired ESS (licensed for surveillance cameras) who took down the old one and installed a new one, outside of building (different kind than the Axis)
 - Worked w/ESS to configure the software and there is a storage drive.
 - At the moment, the public can't see live feed at Owen Park, I will have to work with camera vendor to configure this.
- Worked w/our vendor to work with another vendor for the smart upgrades at the ESF building. Shortly after the new fiscal year contract was sign and equipment was ordered.
 - o I check each week on the status of the equipment, there was a back order.
 - Last update (week of 9/19) the equipment should be arriving this week.
 - The upgrades will be smart boards/speakers for the training room and a smaller one in the command center.
 - Software, training overview how to run the boards
 - Zoom capability
 - Cameras front and back of the room for hybrid meetings as well as training.
- Same upgrade article: surveillance cameras will be replacing the nonworking ones on the outside of the ESS building and now two new ones in the EMS bays
 - Vendor has scoped out to see if existing wiring can be reused.
 - Vendor will be installing a storage unit to hold 30 days' worth of footage and training on how to recall.
 - Vendor will be onsite next week to install what he has in inventory for camera's and put temporary lower grade ones in until the rest come in.
- Worked with Finance, Water Works, and Wastewater for new utility billing.
- Setup and configured new workstation for new person at the ESF building.
 - o IP CAT6 cable needed to be run from workstation to Server room across the building as what was there was an older cable (CAT3)
 - Hired electrical company to do this work, I finished the connection.
- Still waiting on parking kiosk to get delivered and installed from the vendor.
 - o This device was signed for and ordered last fall.
 - o I am in constant communication with vendors to get weekly updates.
 - Unit was shipped from the ordering vendor to the configuration vendor.
 - o This vendor did not have anyone to deliver the device to the island all winter and spring.
 - The vendors tech person had been trying to get reservations all summer and could not.
 - I had asked if they could just go in standby, waiting to hear back from them.
- The parking kiosk at the Park n Ride had some software issues last month, these issues were reported to tech support for resolution.
- Signal extender is installed (on the pole) at the town parking lot for the handhelds to read license plates when the parking kiosk is installed.
- Started to get the website upgrade on the board for FY23, will need to complete current projects before all focus are on this project as it will take much time.
 - o Will be signing contract in the next month or so.

- DPW was down for a few days when fluctuating power surges blew a major switch at the DPW.
 - o Order switches and replaced switch all services were restored.
- Worked w/vendor to troubleshoot (no service contract) the gas terminal at DPW for a few weeks, problem is resolved.
- Website postings, maintenance, and user support, continue working with new committees to get them up to speed on posting to their page.
- User Support (network, workstation, Windows, Zoom, TeamViewer, cameras, MS Office365 and software).
- Troubleshoot user, workstation, network, and various other issues that arise.
- Server Maintenance in various town buildings.
