


Staffing Staffing is increasingly challenging due to the nationwide shortages of certified professionals. There are two applications for the vacant paramedic position.

Equipment Oxygen tanks that are 10 years and older are being replace. The oxygen generator has been repaired and is back in service.


Education All Tisbury paramedics have completed their EKG competencies and have received their continued authorization to practice.
