requirements.


**Education** Prior to the March 31<sup>st</sup> 2022 deadline, all full-time, per diem and volunteer EMT's and


paramedics have successful completed the training requirements and recertification

process.


All affiliated paramedics are scheduled to complete their EKG competencies in April.
