Draft Aquaculture Mooring Regulations

CHAPTER II. MOORING REGULATIONS FOR TISBURY WATERWAYS

XIX. MOORING CATEGORIES

D. AQUACULTURE MOORINGS:

The Harbormaster, as authorized by the Board of Selectmen and pursuant to MGL. Chp 91 Sec. 10A, if so requested by the applicant, shall issue up to two moorings for the sole and exclusive use of aquaculture as required in the Army Corps of Engineers application process. (BOS 4/7/2020)

- Aquaculture moorings shall be used for rafts, for the sole purpose of growing, upwelling, antifouling, culling, and/or sorting.
- Aquaculture moorings shall be exempt from annual mooring fees and be subject to all other
 mooring regulations as outlined in the Tisbury Waterways Regulations, (Sec XXXI), Mooring
 Care and Maintenance.
