Community Preservation Committee

The Community Preservation Act (CPA) enables Massachusetts communities to levy a surcharge on property tax bills to raise funds to expand their open space, historic, recreational and affordable housing assets. A nine-member Community Preservation Committee (CPC) helps develop and administer projects funded with CPA monies. It encourages participation by interested community members, and all recommended projects are specifically voted on at Town meeting by the citizens of Tisbury.

Tisbury has appropriated \$7,821,602 over the past twelve years, FY2006 –FY2018. This year's (FY 2019) completed CPC projects include:
