Dinghies removed from town landings

More than one month after a December 15 deadline to remove all kayaks, inflatables and dinghies not being actively used to attend a vessel from town landings, the Tisbury Harbor Department, with the assistance of the Department of Public Works and Shellfish Constable Danielle Ewart, set about removing a collection of watercraft from Lake Street landing, Owen Park landing and the Lagoon Pond landing.

Prior to the December deadline the harbor department advertised and posted notices at the landing areas that all dinghies not in use must be removed.

A DPW crew and trucks cleared a total of more than 50 dinghies of all variety from town property.

Owners may reclaim their dinghies by calling the harbor department at 508-696-4249. There is a \$50 fee.
