

**THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL AND EXTENSION OF
Emergency Order for a Temporary Moratorium on all construction projects in Tisbury**

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, the Boards of Selectmen and Health adopted, and on March 25, 2020 amended, an order imposing an emergency temporary moratorium on construction activity in the Town, effective until 12:00 p.m. on April 7, 2020 (the “Construction Activity Order”);

WHEREAS, the Governor of the Commonwealth has declared a state of emergency in response to COVID-19, and has issued a further Order on March 23, 2020, entitled COVID-19 Order No. 13, and, whereas, on April 28, 2020, the Governor extended COVID-19 Order No. 13 until May 18, 2020, by COVID-19 Order No. 30;

WHEREAS, effective Friday, April 3, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., the Town extended its Construction Activity Order until April 21, at 12:00 p.m.

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2020, the Boards of Selectmen and Health, effective April 22, 2020, at 8:00 a.m., extended the Construction Activity Order to April 27, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. and, effective April 27, 2020, at 8:00 a.m., through May 4, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., amended and supplemented the Construction Activity Order as follows:

“Construction Activity at One- and Two-Worker Construction Sites only may commence (on April 27, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.); provided, however, that any work at One- and Two-Worker Construction Sites must strictly follow and observe the “Martha’s Vineyard Construction Guidelines – Rules for Getting Back to Work Phase 1”, attached hereto.”

NOW, THEREFORE, in order to protect the health and safety of the residents of and workers within the Town, the Boards of Selectmen and Health further extend and supplement the Construction Activity Order, as amended and supplemented on April 17, 2020, as follows:

- 1.) The existing order shall remain in effect until May 11, 2020, at 8:00 a.m.; however, beginning on May 4, 2020 housecleaners are permitted to begin working in unoccupied dwellings only, provided they comply with the Martha’s Vineyard Construction Guidelines – Rules for Getting Back to Work Phase 1;
- 2.) Beginning on May 11, 2020, at 8:00 a.m., Construction Sites are permitted to have up to five (5) workers at any one time; provided, any work must strictly follow and observe the “Martha’s Vineyard Construction Guidelines – Rules for Getting Back to Work Phase 1.5.” Further, beginning on May 11, 2020, at 8:00 a.m., work at Construction Sites may include work on occupied buildings provided the guidelines and protocols for such work issued by the Board of Health are followed.

3.) Beginning on May 18, 2020, at 8:00 a.m., and subject to compliance with the “Martha’s Vineyard Construction Guidelines – Rules for Getting Back to Work Phase 2,” to be adopted by the Board of Health, Construction Sites are permitted to have up to ten (10) workers. A request may be made to the Town for authority to have more than ten (10) workers at a Construction Site, after May 18, 2020, at 8:00 a.m., by submitting the “long form” request, available on the Board of Health’s webpage.

THIS EXTENSION AND SUPPLEMENT IS SUBJECT TO FURTHER ORDER OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH AND BOARD OF SELECTMEN.
